Literacy is Transformative

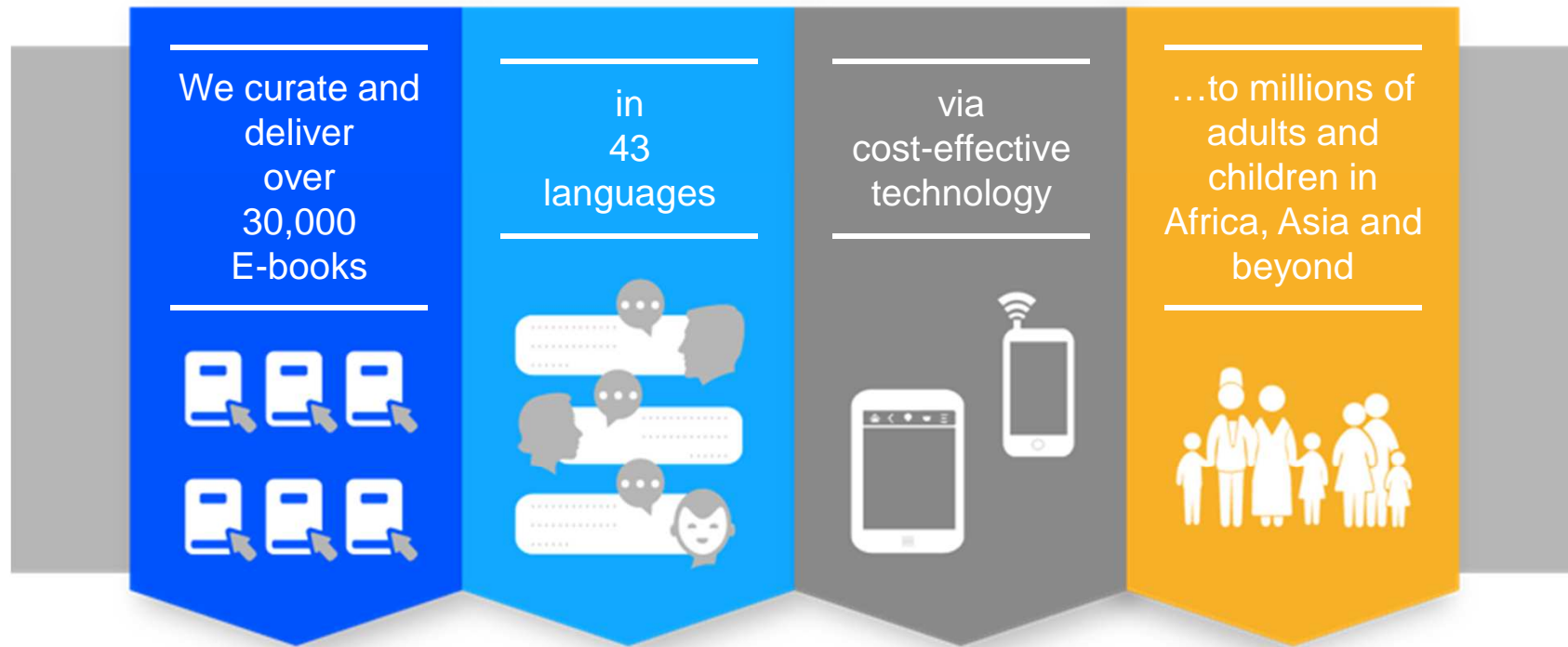


Literacy increases earning potential, decreases inequality, improves health outcomes and breaks the cycle of poverty.

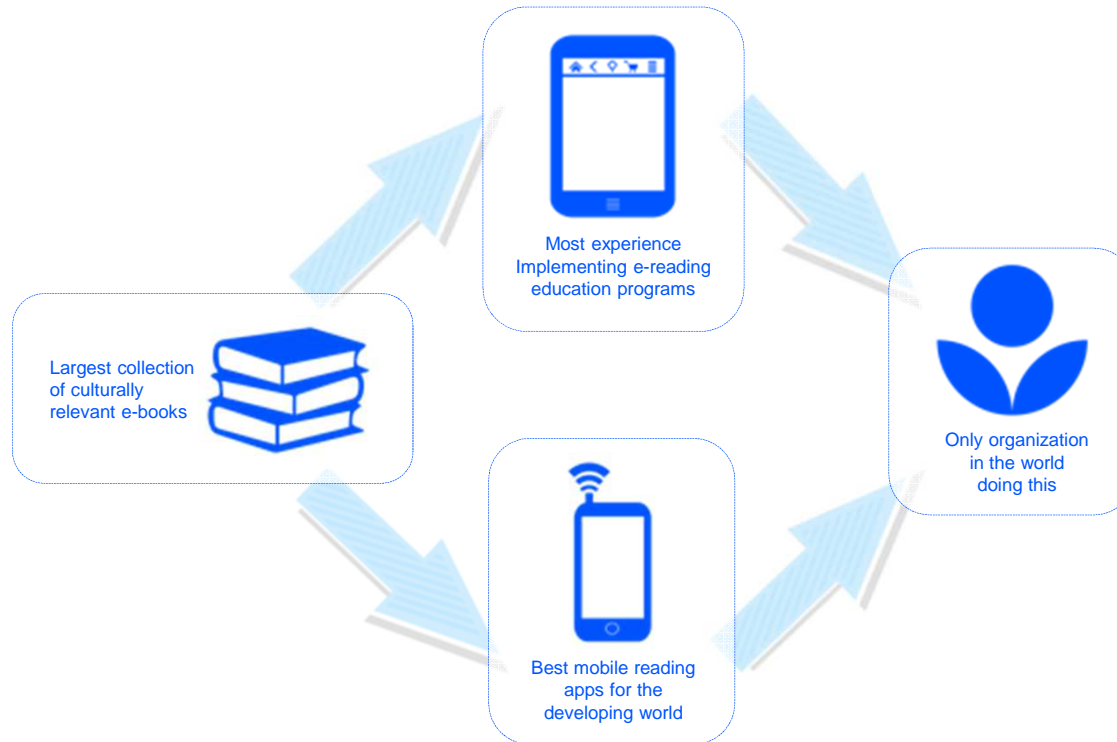
Yet there are 740 million illiterate people in the world and 250 million children of primary school age who lack basic reading and writing skills (UNESCO).

Books are necessary for the development of these skills, and still 50% of schools in Africa have few or no books at all (SAQMEC).

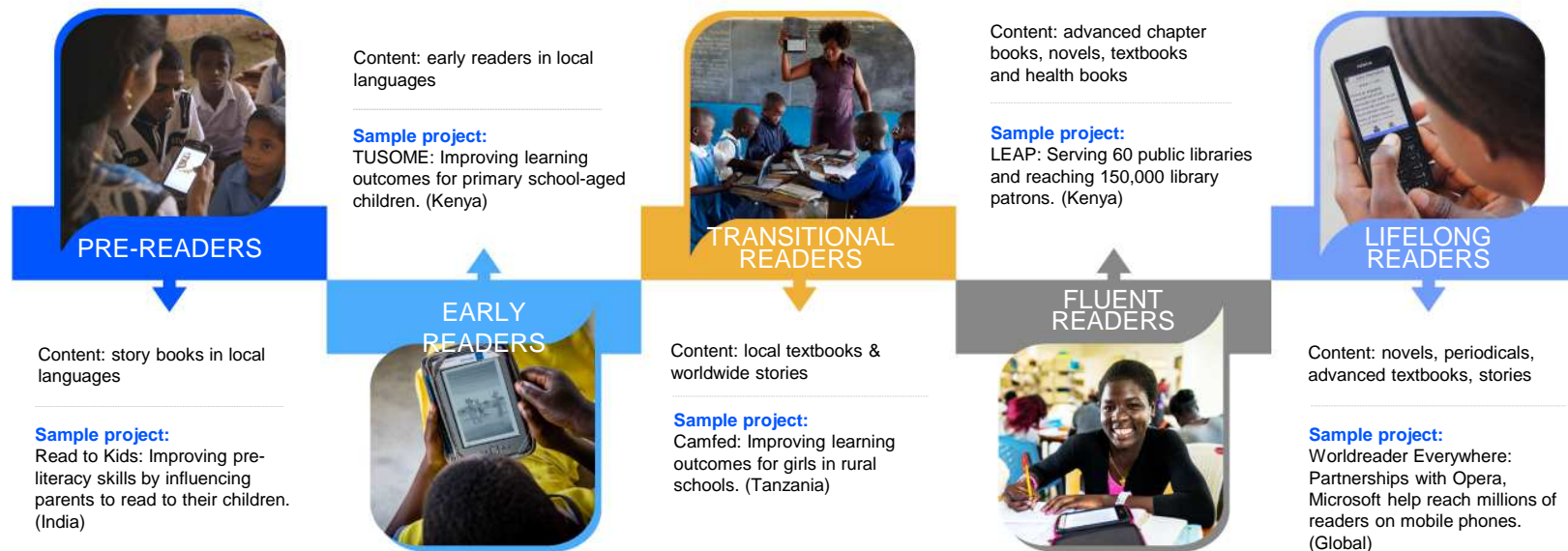
